


Arizona State Capitol




Arizona's Annual General Fund

• K-12 education: 43.5% of budget





- AZ Median teacher salary: **48th** in US
- **46th** in per-student spending
- AZ spends \$5,500 less per pupil than national average
- 2nd most crowded class sizes in US

 Despite our classroom crisis, AZ is consistently ranked "#1 in School Choice" by those seeking to privatize public education

Our Focus

Support Legislation that:

- Increases investment of public funds in public schools
- Increases transparency and accountability for all schools receiving taxpayer dollars



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Oppose Legislation that:

• Diverts more public dollars to private schools via ESA vouchers, STO vouchers, etc.

Our Goals

- Inform and engage parents, teachers, retirees & other citizens all around AZ
- Develop an army of engaged citizens who understand how policy impacts schools & children
- Help citizens engage with lawmakers to gain support for public schools







Current Legislation



HB2112, Udall (R-25), bans the teaching on controversial subjects.

HB2439, Pingerelli (R-21), would require school boards to approve every single school library book

SB1159, Gray (R-21), waters down requirements to become a teacher.

SB1657, Boyer (R-20), is a near-universal ESA voucher expansion

HB2808, Udall (R-25), takes a punitive approach to "failing schools," which are mainly low-income, rural, and on reservation lands.

You Can Make a Difference in this Budget

As session stretches on, all eyes are on lawmakers as they work toward a budget. Some lawmakers say they are focusing on a big-picture view of other issues rather than prioritizing education funding. However, Arizona is far from "checking the box" on education funding. Getting our state to just "average" (the national median) would require billions of dollars in additional investment.

As these budget discussions continue, YOUR presence in the House and Senate galleries will help remind lawmakers that our schools remain in desperate need of resources. Educators and students can't be there because they're at school — so we are counting on the amazing SOSAZ network of parents, retirees and concerned citizens to show lawmakers the community supports public schools and wants them to be funded. 



What is RTS - Request to Speak

- RTS is an online tool to give Arizona State legislators your feedback on bills.
- RTS allows you to register your support or opposition on a bill and provide the reason why.
- You do not have to speak as the name implies.
- It's an easy way to share your opinions directly with legislators, all from the comfort of your home or kitchen table!

- Hi, my name is _____ and I live in LD__. (Add a personal note about your connection with schools).
- I want to thank {Lawmaker's title and name} for supporting **public** schools.
- I am concerned about / supportive of {Bill #} because (give your reasoning based on weekly report, a simple sentence will do).
- Their staffer will record your position. That's it!

But... What Do I Say?



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Do:

- Trust your voice and tell your story
- Speak to the issue
- Try to offer a positive
- Clearly state your position



Don't:

- Attack the staffer
- Demean the
 lawmaker or their
 party affiliation
- Use swear words or get angry

Advocating at the Capitol



- Schedule a meeting with your lawmaker(s)
- Call ahead and make an appt
- Similar advice to calls: introduce yourself, explain why you believe in public schools, and why you believe the need more investments
- Bring a friend! Feel free to bring handwritten notes, etc.




Advocating at the Capitol
