#### **Ranked Choice Voting**

Ranked Choice Voting (RCV) is growing in popularity nationwide, and is seen as one solution to our broken system of voter disenfranchisement and weak legislative outcomes. RCV is a simple upgrade to the way we vote where voters rank candidates and the winner has a true majority, but the benefits extend beyond the voting booth. Voter Choice Arizona is working to bring RCV to Arizona in 2024 through a ballot initiative to give voters more choice, more voice, and better governance. What is RCV, how will it be implemented in AZ, and why should we support it will be topics for our January meeting.
