- To identify and inform members of current legislation at both state and federal levels.
- To help Get out the Vote.

Outreach Committee

- To identify and network to other clubs such as N.O.W., Indivisible, and Legislative Districts.
- To reach out to gun safety groups such as Moms Demand Action.
- To reach out to Independents and dissatisfied Republicans and non-voters.

Education Committee

- To promote funding of public schools, especially teacher pay.
- To support electing a democratic legislature to accomplish this.
- To oppose legislature intrusion into education such as book banning.
- To educate Club members about various topics such as Climate change with emphasis on water, fossil fuel, solar, and other

renewable energy.

Mission Committee

- To be a politically active club.
- To promote a positive active agenda of what we are for and not what we are against.
- To adopt a list of talking points and questions to provide speakers.

Action Committee

- To organize various political actions/demonstrations.
- To support and advocate for comprehensive health care, including abortion, and universal Healthcare.
- To make phone calls and write postcards.
